



Introduction to Angela Ehling

Angela Ehling is a PhD geologist working at the Federal Institute for Geosciences and Natural Resources (BGR) in Berlin since 1991. She is responsible for the Geoscientific collections of the BGR, including one of the largest dimension stone collection in Germany. The special expertise and engagement is in the field of natural building stones, amongst others as a consultant of the German government in the matter of dimension stones at governmental buildings and as a guest lecturer at the FH Potsdam, department of stone restoration.

She is co-founder and board member of the German network "Stones in the city", board member of the German commission for the declaration of the "Stone of the year" as well as founder and speaker of the German Heritage Stone group.

In 2020, she is approved as vice chair of the IUGS International Commission on Geoheritage.
